Our entertainment lineup includes a welcome program on Wednesday evening, musical programs by professionals on Thursday and Saturday evenings and a presentation by a member of the Monroe County Historical Association on Friday evening.

The Penn-Lehigh Unit has been having a Unit rally at Gilbert each year for over 35 years so we know the area. The tours we have selected for you include visits to Quiet Valley Living Historical Farm, the Asa Packer Mansion and the town of Jim Thorpe, Bushkill Falls, Delaware Water Gap Trolley, the Crayola Factory and the Nation Cana Museum in Easton and others. We will also have some on-site activities such as a craft sale/flea market, a seminar about gardening by a Penn-Lehigh member who is a Master Gardener, a short meeting of Pennsylvania Unit Presidents, a Hassel-Tassel happy hour and lots of time for sitting around and sharing stories.

For members who can't arrive at the rally until Friday, we are offering a special "weekend only" fee. See the coupon section for details.
