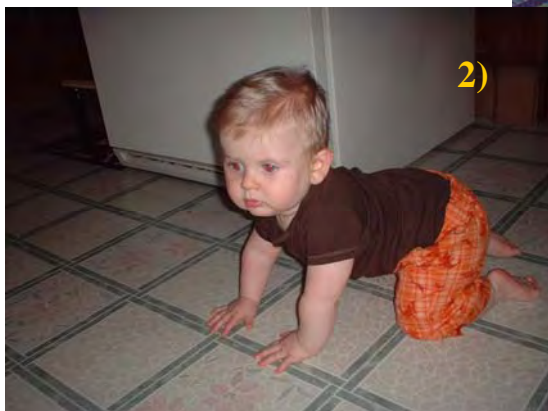

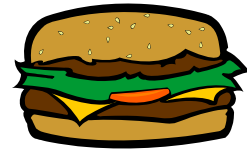
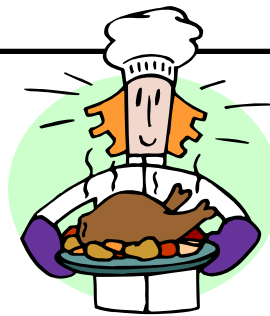

CHIPPOKES PLANTATION STATE PARK
October 1 - 4, 2009

We are again going to have a community service at Chippokes Plantation State Park in Surry, Virginia. This year it will be a joining the Virginia Tidewater Unit for their Take Pride in America rally. Those of you that were with us last time remember that we not only enjoyed ourselves, we contributed a great deal to beautifying the Park in preparation for the new camping season. The Park Ranger, Donette Poole welcomes us back to a newly improved facility which includes new, level camp sites. The Park will supply us with all the items we need to do the chores, however, if you have your own favorite tools to accomplish light garden work as well as minor carpentry, please bring them along.

Everyone please bring you own pair of gloves!

We will arrive on Thursday October 1st and work on projects at Chippokes on Friday and Saturday. Betty will provide evening meals on Friday and Saturday and continental breakfast on Sunday morning. We are planning to go to the Surry Inn for dinner on Thursday for those who want to go out for dinner.

Chippokes Park is located in Surry, VA. The easiest way to reach the Park from the North is to take I295 off of I95 at Richmond and follow I295 until Exit 15A, SR-10. Follow SR-10 through the town of Surry until you see Chippokes signs at either Alliance Rd (approx 1.9 miles from light in Surry) or if you miss it, Chippokes Farm Rd (approx 7.2 miles from light in Surry) Both are left turns and lead to park entrance. Once inside the Park, the campsites are marked. If you are coming from the Jamestown-Scotland Ferry, follow the instructions given from the light in Surry.
